- ASHEVILLE LOCATION -

We have a few important changes to our schedule this year. Please note that your dancer's class section must be approved by Ms. Heather. In order to keep class sizes small, we are dividing up classes by the following levels:

BEGINNERS

Mondays - 5:15pm to 6:00pm
- Beginner II Soft Shoe:
Mondays - 5:15pm to 6:30pm
- Beginner Hard Shoe:
Wednesdays - 5:45pm to 6:45pm

INTERMEDIATE / CHAMP

Novice & UP level

- Intermediate/Champ:
Mondays - 6:45pm to 8:15pm
- Intermediate/Champ:
Wednesdays - 7:00pm to 8:30pm

OIREACHTAS DANCERS

Novice & UP level

*There is an added class this year on Fridays from 3:30-5:00pm (will not happen on FEIS weekends)

2020 - 2021 PAYMENT STRUCTURE

- ASHEVILLE LOCATION -

Tuition for the 2020 - 2021 year will be based on a monthly tuition payments rather than terms. The tuition payments will be for regular class time only and WILL NOT include the workshops. We have taken those out and will be paid separately to Ms. Amanda when she comes to Asheville for the workshops.

CLASSES

- Beginner I Class \$65/month
- Beginner II Class \$75/month
- 2 Beginner Classes
\$100/month
- Int./Champ Class
\$90/month
- 2 Int./Champ Classes
\$110/month
- 3 Int./Champ Classes
\$150/month

WORKSHOPS

- Beginner Soft Shoe - \$40
- Beginner/Adv Beginner
Soft Shoe - \$70
- Beginner/Adv Beginner
Hard Shoe - \$70
- Int./Champ - \$140

Remember that workshops are mandatory for all dancers attending the Oireachtas.

PAYMENT TERMS

- We accept cash, check, and automatic payments. Families will receive an Invoice through Bill.com to set up their payments.
- ANY tuition turned in past the 15th of each month must include a \$10 late fee. No exceptions.
- Please note - tuition is half off for siblings. If your dancer has a sibling interested in lessons this term, please let me know.

SOCIAL DISTANCING POLICIES

- ASHEVILLE LOCATION -

STUDIO POLICIES

Here at Carpenter Academy, the health and safety of our dancers and families is our utmost concern. We have put the following policies in place for Fall 2020:

- Class sizes are limited to 8 students per class for a total of 16 students to allow for social distancing in the studio,
- Dancers show ANY symptoms of illness **WILL NOT** be permitted in the studio. Instructors reserve the right to ask a dancer to leave class if they are ill.
- Currently, instructors and students are required to wear masks during class. We will provide a "mask-break" area outdoors for students and staff.

ENTERING/EXITING

- There are 15 minute breaks scheduled in between classes to allow students to enter & exit at different times In order to avoid mixing classes. This will also give the instructors time to sanitize the studio before the next class.
- Your instructor will come outside and signal to you when the studio has been sanitized and your class is permitted to enter the studio.
- Dancers will be permitted to enter the studio 5 minutes before their scheduled class time, NO earlier. Please do not enter the studio without your instructor's permission.
- Please do your best to arrive on time. If the class has already begun, please wait patiently until your instructor signals you to enter.

HANDS FREE

Our studio facilities have been updated to Include the following:

- Multiple hand sanitizer stations throughout the studio
- Touchless soap dispenser
- Automatic paper towel dispenser

These updates have allowed us to limit the points of contact In the studio.

SOCIAL DISTANCING POLICIES

STUDIO POLICIES

- Student's temperatures will be taken using a no-touch thermometer before entering the building.
- When entering the studio, please use the hand sanitizer provided to the right of the door. If you are allergic to hand sanitizer, please wash your hands immediately after arriving to the studio.
- Go directly to your assigned space around the edge of the room. These spaces are 8 feet apart to allow for social distancing.
- When drilling in class, please dance in your assigned box square on the floor. Boxes for drilling are 8 feet apart to allow for social distancing.
- Dancers are asked to bring small dance bags to class with only the necessary items they need for class - i.e. shoes, tape, etc.
- Dancers are asked to bring reusable water bottles from home. Please put your name on the waterbottle to avoid mixing drinks accidentally.

EXPOSURE POLICIES

- If a dancer or family member has been potentially exposed to COVID-19, the dancer must be symptom free for 10 days before returning to class.
- Students are NOT permitted to attend class if any member of their household presents symptoms or tests positive. They may return to class once the household has been symptom free for 14 days.
- Families must notify CAID-Asheville within 24 hours of potential exposure or symptoms appearing. Please send an email to heather@carpenteririshdance.com.

PARENTS

- Parents/siblings will NOT be allowed in the studio. Only dancers registered with the Carpenter Academy will be permitted in the studio during their designated class time.
- Our studio restrooms will only be available to students taking classes.
- Parents are asked to wait in or by their cars instead of congregating in the studio during class release times. Instructors will walk all classes out to their cars at the end of class.
- Parents, please email Ms. Heather with any questions. If you would like to have a meeting via Zoom, this must be scheduled in advance.
